RESOLVE in favor of the Town of Monticello, in the
County of Aroostook.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropri-
2 ated the sum of five hundred dollars to be ex-
3 pended under the direction of an agent to be ap-
4 pointed by the Governor and Council, in building
5 a bridge across Meduxnekeag Stream, in the town
6 of Monticello, in the county of Aroostook.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The travel across Meduxnekeag Stream passes over a wooden bridge more than twenty-five years old, and never was a suitable bridge. That the situation is such that the expense would be greater than the town of Monticello could afford in their present circumstances. That said town beside building all their other roads could not unaided build such a bridge as the situation requires.

The estimated cost of said bridge is \$2500.
