STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes, relating to Malicious Mischiefs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section one of chapter one hundred and twenty-
2 seven of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended
3 by inserting after the word "any" and before the
4 word "domestic," in the second line, the words
5 'dog or' and inserting after the word "animal" in
6 the third line, the words 'or dog,' so that said sec-
7 tion as amended shall read as follows :

'SECT. 1. Whoever wilfully or maliciously kills,
9 wounds, maims, disfigures or poisons any dog or

10 domestic animal or exposes any poisonous sub-
11 stance with intent that the life of such animal or
12 dog should be destroyed thereby, shall be punished
13 by imprisonment for not more than four years or
14 by fine not exceeding five hundred dollars.'
