5 eighty-seven.

Mrs. Lelia Pattee of Harmony is the widow of Geo. H. Pattee, late a private in the Sixth Battery, Maine Volunteers, who was killed by the premature explosion of a blast, in a granite quarry, at Vinalhaven, Maine, in the month of —, 188 .
