STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section five, chapter fifty-eight
of the Revised Statutes, relating to Reports of Sec-
retary of the Board of Agriculture.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section five of chapter fifty-eight of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
3 word "ten" in the twelfth line thereof, and insert-
4 ing instead the word 'twenty,' also by striking out
5 the words " five thousand bound in paper covers and
6 five thousand in cloth," in lines thirteen and four-
7 teen, and inserting instead the words ' all bound in
8 cloth,' so that the concluding part of said section
9 as amended shall read as follows:

‘Twenty thousand copies of said report shall be
11 printed, all bound in cloth, one-half of each for the
12 Legislature, and the remainder after reserving a
13 suitable number for foreign exchanges, for distri-
14 bution under the direction of the board, among the
15 agricultural institutions and the people of the
16 State.’
