STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to Compensation of County Com- missioners of Hancock County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. On and after January first, A. D.
2 eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, each County
3 Commissioner of Hancock County shall receive two
4 dollars and fifty cents a day while actually employed
5 in the service of the county, including the time
6 spent in travelling, for which every commissioner
7 shall have ten cents a mile for the distance act-
8 ually travelled; but no commissioner shall have
9 more than one travel during the same hearing or
10 session, or for more than two adjournments of any

11 regular term; nor for service or travel on more than
12 one petition or case at the same time; nor anything
13 for travel or attendance at the Legislature connected
14 with the annual county estimates; nor for any ad-
15 ditional trouble or expense.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
