STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That the Treasurer of the State, be
2 authorized and directed to receive from the Maine
3 Insane Hospital, the sum of fifty thousand dollars,
4 bequeathed to said hospital by Honorable Abner
5 Coburn; and said Treasurer shall apply the same
6 in payment of the debt of the State of Maine, and
7 said Treasurer shall issue to said hospital, an unne-
8 gotiable registered bond for the sum of fifty thou-
9 sand dollars, bearing interest at the rate of four
10 per cent. per annum, payable, semi-annually, on
11 the first days of January and July, in each year,
12 at the Treasurer's office; said bond shall be paya-
13 ble in thirty years from the first day of July, A.
14 D., 1887; shall be signed by the Treasurer, counter-

15 signed by the Governor, and attested by the Sec-
16 retary of the State; and the State Treasurer, and
17 his successors in office, shall pay to the Treasurer
18 of said hospital, the interest on said bond until its
19 maturity.
