IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the Size of Clam Bait Barrels.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. In all contracts relating to the sale  
2 of clam bait by the barrel, and clam bait barrels,  
3 unless otherwise specified in the contract, a barrel  
4 shall be twenty-seven and one-half inches long,  
5 sixteen inches head diameter outside measure,  
6 holding not less than twenty-one gallons, and not  
7 more than twenty-three gallons.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect the first day  
2 of August, A. D., 1887.
