IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-one of chapter forty of Revised Statutes, relating to Migratory Fishes in Damariscotta River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirty-one of chapter forty of the Revised
2 Statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the
3 words "so much of the waters of Damariscotta
4 river as are west of the railroad bridge near Dam-
5 ariscotta Mills," so that said section as amended,
6 shall read as follows:

'SECT. 31. The following waters and their tribu-
8 taries are exempt from provisions relating to migra-
9 tory fishes, and the supervision of fish-ways by the

10 Commissioners, that is to say: Royall's river in
11 North Yarmouth; Sewall's Pond, or its outlet, in
12 Arrowsic; Nequasset stream in Woolwich; Duck
13 trap stream in Lincolnville and Belmont; the east-
14 ern Penobscot river in Orland; Winslow's and
15 Leach's streams in Penobscot; all waters in Vinal-
16 haven, Bluehill, Tremont, Mount Desert, Eden,
17 Franklin and Sullivan; Tunk river in Steuben;
18 Pleasant river in Washington county; East Ma-
19 chias river, and Cobscook or Orange river in
20 Whiting.
