IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-four of chapter
sixty-five of the Revised Statutes, relating to allow-
ances to widows.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section twenty-four of chapter sixty-
2 five of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended so
3 as to read as follows:

‘SECT. 24. A widow shall have her reasonable
5 sustenance out of the estate of her husband for
6 ninety days after his death; and may remain in the
7 house of her husband during said ninety days with-
8 out being chargeable with rent therefor.’

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
