EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to County Roads in Unincor-
porated Townships.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

County commissioners, when county roads in un-
2 incorporated townships and tracts of lands in their
3 counties are blocked or encumbered with snow,
4 may forthwith cause so much of it to be removed
5 or trodden down as will render them passable; and
5 may appoint an agent or agents, not members of
7 their own board, to superintend the expenditure
8 therefor, who shall give bond as provided in section
9 seventy-eight, chapter six of the Revised Statutes,
10 if required; the whole expense whereof shall be
11 borne by the county.
