STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to establish a salary for the Clerk of Courts
in Oxford County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. From and after the first day of
2 April, eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, the
3 salary of the clerk of courts for Oxford county
4 shall be one thousand dollars per annum, payable
5 quarterly from the county treasury, on the last
6 days of March, June, September and December of
7 each year, for the quarters preceding, to be in full of
8 all services as clerk of the supreme judicial court,
9 and of the county commissioners' court; and he
10 shall account, under oath, for all fees received by

11 him, or which he is entitled to receive by virtue of
12 his office, and pay them over to the county treas-
13 urer on the last days of June and December of
14 each year.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
