## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

**AN ACT** additional to chapter six of the Revised Statutes, providing for re-assessment of Taxes in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Any tax, except a poll tax, which is 2 invalid by reason of any error or irregularity in the 3 assessment, and which has not been paid, or which 4 has been recovered back, may be re-assessed by the 5 assessors for the time being, at any time within two 6 years from commitment, to the just amount to 7 which, and upon the estate to whom, such tax 8 ought at first to have been assessed, whether such 9 person has continued an inhabitant of the same 10 city or town or not.

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SECT. 2. Taxes re-assessed under the provisions 2 of the preceding section shall be collected and paid 3 over in the same manner as other taxes, and in the 4 warrant to the collector the name of the person to 5 whom the taxes were originally assessed shall be 6 stated. The bond of the collector for the time be-7 ing, to whom the warrant may be committed, shall 8 apply to such re-assessed tax.
