STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the Treasurer of State to re-
fund certain Taxes.

Resolved, That the Treasurer of State be and is
2 hereby authorized and directed to refund to the
3 several towns and plantations included in "An Act
4 to correct the taxation of certain plantations," ap-
5 proved February first, eighteen hundred and eighty-
6 seven, and "An Act to amend 'An Act to correct
7 the taxation of certain plantations,'" approved
8 February twenty-eighth, eighteen hundred and
9 eighty-seven, such sums of money as may have
10 been paid into the State Treasury prior to the ap-
11 proval of the last-named act, on account of State
12 taxes of eighteen hundred and eighty-six.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Under section two of the first named act all State and county taxes heretofore assessed against the plantation therein named, and *remaining unpaid*, were abated.

A few of these plantations having paid the State tax of 1886 prior to the passage of the acts referred to, this Resolve is for the purpose of placing all upon the same basis.
