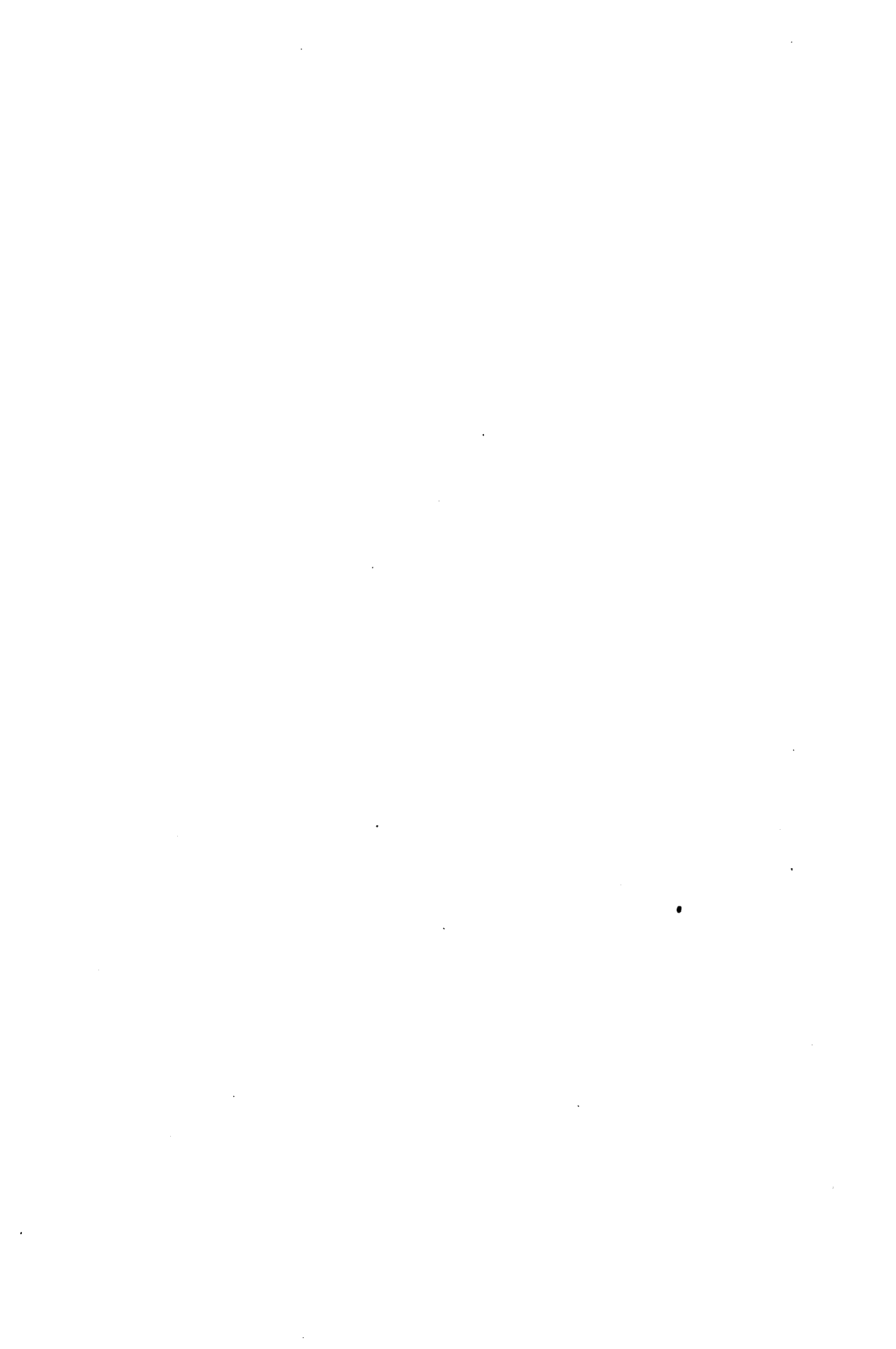
AN ACT to regulate the sale of Opium, Morphine  
and Laudanum.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person, except a registered  
2 apothecary, or a physician of regular standing in  
3 his profession, shall furnish, sell, or keep for sale,  
4 any opium, morphine or laudanum.

SECT. 2. Any person violating this act shall be  
2 punished by a fine of not less than five nor more  
3 than fifty dollars for each offense, to be recovered  
4 by complaint or indictment.
