STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An Act to correct the taxation of certain plantations," approved February first, eighteen hundred and eighty-seven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The act entitled "An Act to correct the taxation
2 of certain plantations," approved February first,
3 eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, is hereby
4 amended by adding at the end of the second sec-
5 tion the words 'and all moneys apportioned to the
6 several plantations herein named, prior to the year
7 eighteen hundred and eighty-six, on account of
8 school and mill tax funds are hereby withheld, and
9 the Treasurer of State is hereby authorized to
10 cancel the same on his books.'
