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STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend section twenty-six of chapter forty of the Revised Statutes, relating to Fish Weirs.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section twenty-six of chapter forty 2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended as fol- 3 lows, viz: by striking out the words "the materi- 4 als of which are wholly or partially removed 5 annually," so that said section, when amended, 6 shall read as follows, viz:

SECT. 2. 'Owners of shores or flats bordering 2 on the sea coast may extend their fish weirs into 3 tide waters below low water mark; *provided* that

4 they do not obstruct navigation nor interfere with  
5 the rights of others.'
