IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize towns to hold money for
Cemetery Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Any person owning or interested in
2 a lot in a public burial place, of a city or town,
3 may deposit with the Treasurer of such city or
4 town, a sum of money not exceeding five hundred
5 dollars for the purpose of providing for the pres-
6 ervation and care of such lots, or its appurtenances,
7 which sum shall be entered upon the books of the
8 Treasurer and held in accordance with the provis-
9 ions of the ordinances or by-laws of such city or
10 town, in relation to burials.

SECT. 2. A city or town may pass such ordinances or by-laws as may be necessary for the purposes of this act and not repugnant to law, and may receive such money for said purposes and may allow interest thereon at a rate not exceeding six per cent a year.
