STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for protection and propagation of Fish and Game, and for the enforcement of the laws relating thereto.

Resolved, that the sum of twenty thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the protection and propagation of fish and game, and for the enforcement of the laws for the protection thereof, for the years eighteen hundred eighty-seven and eighteen hundred eighty-eight, to be expended under the direction of the Governor and Council, as follows: six thousand five hundred dollars to be expended for the benefit and protection of the inland fisheries and game, and three thousand five hundred dollars for the benefit and protection of the sea and shore fisheries for the year eighteen

13 hundred eighty-seven, and the same sums to be
14 expended in the same manner for the year eighteen
15 hundred eighty-eight.
