STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for erecting a Stand-Pipe in the State House; and for furnishing Hose for the same.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars, or
2 so much thereof as may be needed, be and is here-
3 by appropriated for the purpose of introducing
4 stand-pipes into the State House to secure protec-
5 tion against fire; and the further sum of seven
6 hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated for the purchase
8 of hose to be used in connection therewith, the
9 sums hereby appropriated to be expended under
10 the direction of the Governor and Council.
