IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to Savings Banks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The Treasurer of every Savings Bank
2 or institution of savings shall on or before the first
3 day of November annually deliver to the Bank Ex-
4 aminer a sworn statement containiung the name, the
5 amount standing to his credit, the last known place
6 of residence or post-office address, and the fact of
7 death if known to such Treasurer, of every depos-
8 itor who shall not have made a deposit therein or
9 withdrawn therefrom any part of his deposit or
10 any part of the interest thereon for a period of more
11 than twenty years next preceding; *provided, how-*

12 *ever*, that this act shall not apply to the deposit
13 made by any person known to the bank to be living.

SECT. 2. The Bank Examiner shall communicate
2 the statements which have been delivered to him
3 as provided in section one, in his next annual report
4 to the Governor and Council.

SECT. 3. The Treasurer of any Savings Bank
2 or institution of savings neglecting or refusing to
3 make the sworn statement required by section one,
4 shall be fined one hundred dollars.
