STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to Savings Banks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Treasurer of every Savings Bank

- 2 or institution of savings shall on or before the first
- 3 day of November annually deliver to the Bank Ex-
- 4 aminer a sworn statement containing the name, the
- 5 amount standing to his credit, the last known place
- 6 of residence or post-office address, and the fact of
- 7 death if known to such Treasurer, of every depos-
- 8 itor who shall not have made a deposit therein or
- 9 withdrawn therefrom any part of his deposit or
- 10 any part of the interest thereon for a period of more
- 11 than twenty years next preceding; provided, how-

- 12 ever, that this act shall not apply to the deposit
- 13 made by any person known to the bank to be living.
 - SECT. 2. The Bank Examiner shall communicate
 - 2 the statements which have been delivered to him
 - 3 as provided in section one, in his next annual report
 - 4'to the Governor and Council.
 - SECT. 3. The Treasurer of any Savings Bank
 - 2 or institution of savings neglecting or refusing to
 - 3 make the sworn statement required by section one,
 - 4 shall be fined one hundred dollars.
