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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter fifty-five  
of the Revised Statutes, relating to the Maintenance  
of Town Libraries.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter fifty-five of  
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking  
3 out the word "twenty-five," in the sixth line of said  
4 section, and inserting the word 'fifty' instead, so  
5 that said section as amended shall read as follows,  
6 viz:

'SECT. 9. Any town may establish and maintain  
8 a public library therein, for the use of its inhabi-

9 tants, and provide suitable rooms therefor, under  
10 such regulations for its government as the inhabi-  
11 tants from time to time prescribe; and may appro-  
12 priate, for the foundation and commencement of  
13 such library, a sum not exceeding one dollar, and  
14 for its maintenance and increase annually, a sum  
15 not exceeding fifty cents, for each of its ratable  
16 polls in the year preceding.'

SECT. 2. This act takes effect when approved  
2 by the governor.
