STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND

AN ACT to incorporate the Maine State Society for
the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

37 hereby created a body politic and corporate, by the
38 name of the Maine State Society for the Preven-
39 tion of Cruelty to Animals, with all the powers
40 and privileges, and subject to all the duties, liabili-
41 ties and restrictions provided and set forth in all
42 the general laws which now are or hereafter may
43 be in force relating to such corporations; with
44 authority to hold real and personal estate, for the
45 purposes of the corporation, not exceeding in
46 amount one hundred thousand dollars.

SECT. 2. Either of the first three named corpo-
2 rators are authorized to call the first meeting of said
3 society, by mailing to each corporator a written or
4 printed notice setting forth the time and place of
5 holding said meeting, at least seven days before
6 the time appointed for holding such meeting.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
