STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to authorize the County Commissioners of Franklin County to raise money by loans for the Erection of a County Building for the use of said county in place of the Jail Building recently destroyed by fire.

Resolved, That the County Commissioners of
2 Franklin County be and hereby are authorized to
3 obtain loans of money, for the use of said county
4 of Franklin, and cause notes or obligations, with
5 coupons attached for lawful interest, to be issued
6 for payment thereof at such times as they deem
7 expedient. But [such loans shall not exceed ten
8 thousand dollars.

This resolve shall take effect when approved.
