STATE OF MAINE.

Amend Senate Document No. 18 by striking out "thirtynine thousand seven hundred and eighty-seven dollars and ninety-two cents" and insert 'thirteen thousand dollars; 'also amend by striking out all after "for" in the eighth line to "instruction" in the twelfth line; also amend by striking out "four thousand six hundred eighty-seven dollars and ninety-two cents" in lines twenty-six and twenty-seven and insert instead 'three thousand dollars;' also amend by striking out "five" in line twenty-eight and insert instead 'four,' so that the resolve as amended shall read. 'Resolved that the sum of thirteen thousand dollars be and is hereby appropriated for and in behalf of the Maine State College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts for the years 1887 and 1888, to be expended as follows : Amount to pay for instruction in addition to revenue from endowment fund and tuition, two thousand dollars each year; travelling expenses of the trustees, two hundred and fifty dollars each year; insurance, three hundred dollars each year; apparatus, fifteen hundred dollars in eighteen hundred eighty-seven and one thousand dollars in eighteen hundred and eighty-eight; water supply and sanitary purposes, one thousand dollars; painting shop and repairs in Brick Hall, White Hall and Chemi-

cal Laboratory, five hundred dollars each year; to compensate the farm for the loss sustained by destruction of the herd, ordered by the State Commissioners on Contagious Diseases of Animals, three thousand dollars; to finish the outside of the Goddard Barn, so called, four hundred dollars.
