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AN ACT to repeal Section Eleven, Chapter Sixty of  
the Revised Statutes, relating to granting Divorces  
*nisi*.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section Eleven, Chapter Sixty of the Revised  
2 Statutes, is hereby repealed.
