STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to the exclusion of Minors as
Spectators, from Court Rooms.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Any court or trial justice may ex-
2 clude minors as spectators from the court room
3 during the trial of any cause, civil or criminal,
4 when their presence is not necessary as witnesses
5 or parties.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
