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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend section sixty-four of chapter six  
of the Revised Statutes.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

That section sixty-four of chapter six of the Re-  
2 vided Statutes be amended by inserting after the  
3 words "United States bonds" the following, viz:  
4 'and shares of corporation stocks such as are by  
5 law of this State free from taxation to the stock-  
6 holders,' so that the whole sentence shall read  
7 as follows: 'Every savings bank and institution  
8 for savings incorporated under the laws of the  
9 State shall semi-annually, on the last Saturdays of

10 April and October, make a return, signed and  
11 sworn to by its treasurer of the average amount of  
12 its deposits for the six months preceding each of  
13 said days, deducting an amount equal to the amount  
14 of United States bonds and shares of corporation  
15 stocks, such as are by law of this State free from  
16 taxation to the stockholders, and the value of real  
17 estate, owned by said bank or institution.'
