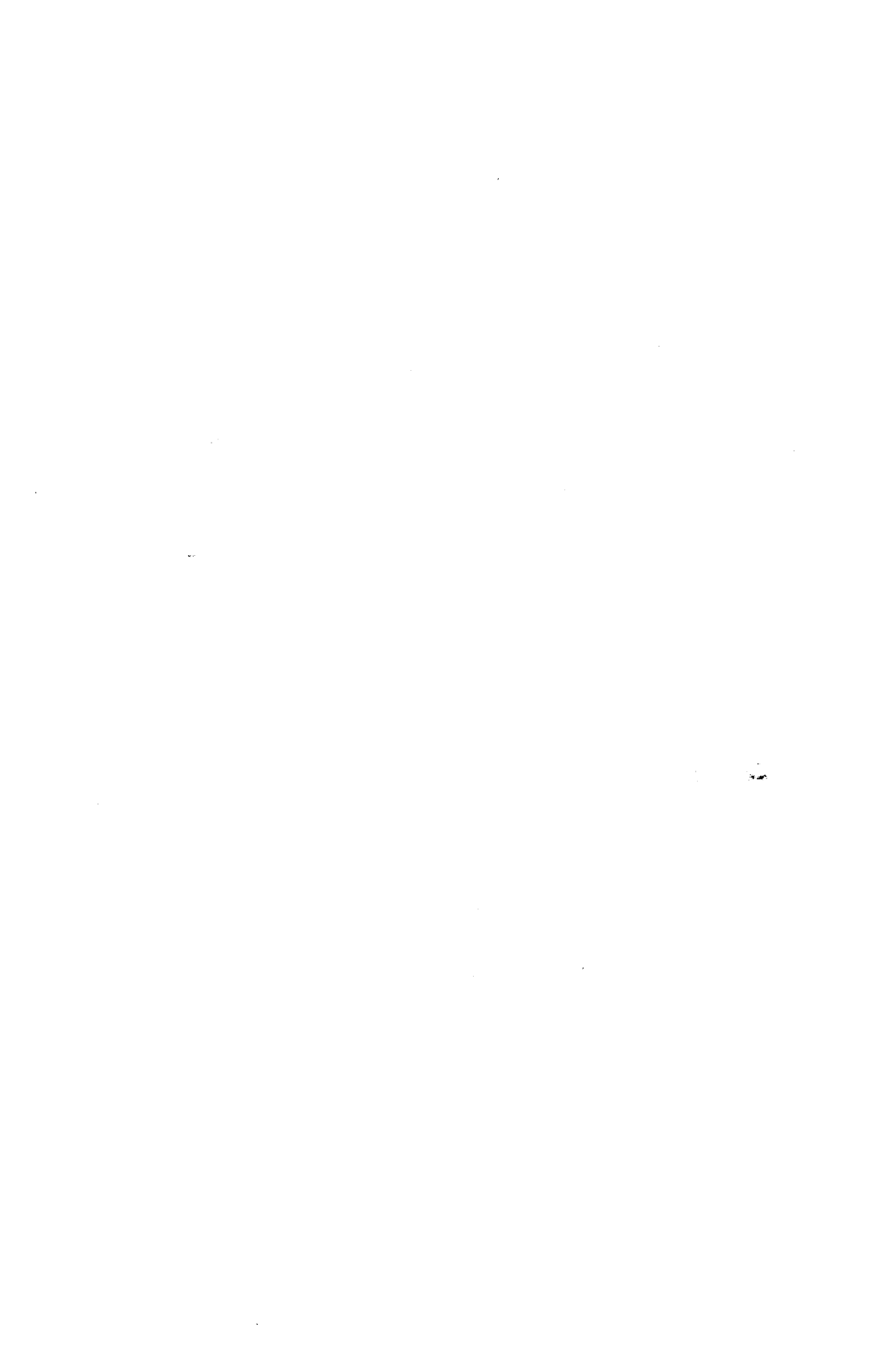
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to chapter fifty-one of the Revised
Statutes, relating to Safety-Switches and Lights.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives

***L**egisla^rure assembled, as follows:*

Every railroad company running express trains
2 in this State shall place safety - switches, of
3 of an approved sort, at every siding connecting
4 with the main track. Switch-lights shall also be
5 maintained throughout that portion of every rail-
6 road where trains are run after dark.
