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STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State College of  
Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

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*Resolved,* That the Treasurer of State be author-  
2 ized and directed to receive from the Maine State  
3 College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts, situ-  
4 ate in Orono, in the county of Penobscot, *in trust,*  
5 the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, be-  
6 queathed to said College, by Honorable Abner  
7 Coburn; and said Treasurer shall apply the same  
8 in payment of the debt of the State of Maine;  
9 and shall issue to said College an unnegoti-  
10 able registered bond for the sum of one hun-  
11 dred thousand dollars bearing interest at the rate  
12 of four per cent per annum, payable semi-annually  
13 on the first days of January and July in each year

14 at the Treasurer's office; said bond shall be payable  
15 in thirty years from the first day of July, A. D.  
16 1887; and shall be signed by the Treasurer,  
17 countersigned by the Governor, and attested by the  
18 Secretary of State; and the State Treasurer and  
19 his successors in office shall pay to the Treasurer  
20 of said College the interest on said bond until its  
21 maturity.
