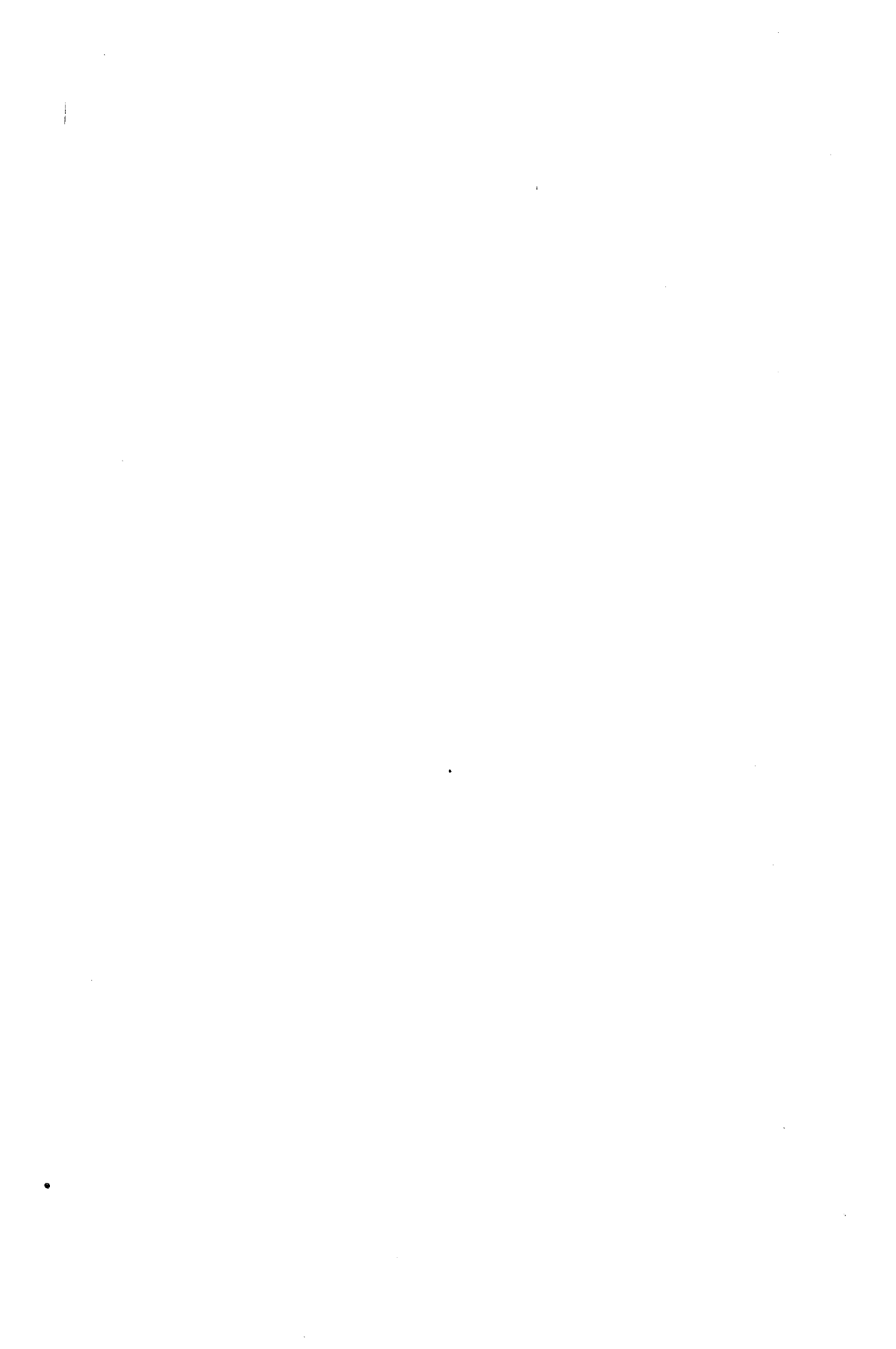

For House Amendment at end of section one, substitute "*Provided, however, any female of eighteen years of age or over may lawfully contract for such labor for any number of hours in excess of said ten hours per day not exceeding six hours in any one week or sixty hours in any one year, receiving additional compensation therefor.*"
