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STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State College of  
Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

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*Resolved,* That the Treasurer of State be author-  
2 ized and directed to receive from the Maine State  
3 College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts situated  
4 in Orono, in the county of Penobscot, in trust, the  
5 sum of one hundred thousand dollars, bequeathed  
6 to said college by Honorable Abner Coburn, and  
7 said Treasurer shall apply the same in payment of  
8 the debt of the State of Maine, and shall issue to  
9 said college an unnegotiable registered bond for  
10 the sum of one hundred thousand dollars bearing  
11 interest at the rate of five per cent per annum,  
12 payable semi-annually on the first days of January  
13 and July in each year at the Treasurer's office;

14 said bond shall be payable in thirty years from the  
15 first day of July, A. D. 1887; and shall be signed  
16 by the Treasurer, countersigned by the Governor;  
17 and attested by the Secretary of State; and the  
18 State Treasurer and his successors in office shall  
19 pay to the treasurer of said college the interest on  
20 said bond from the time he receives said sum  
21 until the maturity of the bond.
