RESOLVE establishing the Valuation for the purposes of Taxation of certain Plantations.

Resolved, That the list of the wild lands, with
2 the number of acres and the value thereof, as con-
3 tained in the schedule hereunto annexed, are hereby
4 taken and established as the number of acres and the
5 true valuation for the purposes of taxation until the
6 further order of the Legislature or a new general
7 valuation be taken.
