STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to provide the remedy in case of damages
caused by flowage by dams erected and maintained
on streams not navigable for the purpose of Cran-
berry Culture.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

When dams are erected and maintained on streams
2 not navigable for the purposes of cranberry culture
3 and lands are flowed thereby and injured by such
4 flowage, the owners thereof shall proceed in the
5 same manner to recover damages for such flowage
6 as in case of flowage by dams erected and main-
7 tained for mill purposes, as provided by chapter
8 ninety-two of the Revised Statutes of the State of
9 Maine.
