STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to accept and assign the grants of money authorized by an act of the Congress of the United States, approved March 3, 1887, entitled "An Act to establish Agricultural Experiment Stations in connection with the Colleges established in the several States under the provisions of an act approved July 2, 1862, and of the acts supplementary thereto."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of carrying into 2 effect the provisions of an act of the Congress of 3 the United States, approved March 3, 1887, to es-4 tablish agricultural experiment stations in connec-

5 tion with the colleges established in the several

- 6 States under the provisions of an act approved
- 7 July 2, 1862, and of the acts supplementary thereto
- 8 the State hereby assents to the purposes of said
- 9 grants and accepts the grants of money author-
- 10 ized and appropriated by said first named act ap-
- 11 proved March 3, 1887, and assigns the same to the
- 12 Maine State College of Agriculture and the Me-
- 13 chanic Arts.
 - SECT. 2. The act of the Legislature of this State
 - 2 approved March 3, 1885, establishing the Maine
 - 3 Fertilizer Control and Agricultural Experiment
 - 4 Station is hereby repealed, this repeal to take effect
 - 5 October 1, 1887.
 - Sect. 3. All apparatus, chemicals and other
 - 2 property belonging to said station and the unex-
 - 3 pended balance of money in the State Treasury
 - 4 appropriated by the State to said Station for the
 - 5 year 1887, shall on October 1, 1887, be transferred
 - 6 and paid to and become the property of the Maine
 - 7 State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic
 - 8 Arts and the treasurer thereof shall receipt for the
 - 9 property so transferred by the Board of Managers
- 10 of said Experiment Station and the unexpended
- 11 balance so paid over by the Treasurer of State.
