STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

An Act to amend section six, chapter one hundred and
thirty-four of the Revised Statutes, relative to wit-
nesses before the Grand Jury.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section six of chapter one hundred and thirty-four
2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended so that
3 the same shall read as follows:

‘SECT. 6. The attorney general, county attorney
5 or foreman of the grand jury, shall swear, or affirm,
6 in presence of the jury, all witnesses who are to
7 testify before them, and a list thereof, stating the
8 cases in which they testify, shall be returned into
9 court by the foreman before the jury is discharged,

10 and filed and entered on record by the clerk. The
11 clerk shall not make such list public until the crim-
12 inal cases, at such term have been tried or other-
13 wise disposed of.'
