STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and fifty-
two, laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five, in
relation to apportionment of School Money.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and fifty-two
2 of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and
3 eighty-five, amending section twelve of chapter
4 eleven of Revised Statutes, is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.

Amend section one by adding the following words : '*Provided* that this section shall not apply to the manufacture by said convicts of any kinds of goods which are not, at the time this bill shall go into effect, elsewhere manufactured in this State.'
