STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-six of chapter thirty of the Revised Statutes, relating to the Disposition of Fines.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section twenty-six of chapter thirty is hereby
2 amended by striking out all of said section after
3 the word "complainant," in the ninth line, and insert
4 the following in lieu thereof, 'and one-half to the
5 use of the county where the action is brought,'
6 so that said section as amended shall read as
7 follows.

'SECT. 26. All penalties imposed by the six pre-
9 ceding sections may be recovered by action of debt,

10 or by complaint or indictment in the name of the
11 State, by any warden or his deputies, or any other
12 person, in any county in which such offence is com-
13 mitted or the accused resides; and in all actions
14 therefor in the supreme judicial or superior courts,
15 if the plaintiff prevails he recovers full costs with-
16 out regard to the amount recovered. All fines and
17 penalties recovered for violations of the seventeen
18 preceding sections, except sections fifteen and six-
19 teen, shall be paid to the county where the action
20 is brought, and all acts and parts of acts inconsis-
21 tent with this act are hereby repealed.'
