STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the Compensation of County
Commissioners of the county of Sagadahoc.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Each County Commissioner for Saga-
dahoc County shall receive two dollars and fifty
cents per day while actually employed in the service
of the county, including the time spent in travelling,
for which he shall have eight cents a mile for the
distance actually travelled; but he shall not have
more than one travel in the same hearing or session,
nor for more than two adjournments of any regu-
lar term, nor for services or travel on more than

10 one petition or case at the same time, nor anything
11 for travel or attendance at the Legislature connected
12 with the annual county estimates, nor for any
13 additional trouble or expense of any kind.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
