STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT amend section four of chapter fifty-nine of
the Revised Statutes, relating to Marriage.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section four of chapter fifty-nine of
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended, so as to
3 read as follows:

‘SECT. 4. Persons intending to be joined in marri-
5 age in this State, shall, before their marriage, cause
6 notice of their intention to be entered in the office
7 of the clerk of the city, town or plantation in which
8 they respectively dwell; or, if they do not dwell
9 within the State, in the office of the clerk of the
10 city, town or plantation in which they propose to

11 have the marriage solemnized. If there is no such
12 clerk in the place of their residence, the entry shall
13 be made in an adjoining city, town or plantation.

SECT. 2. All laws inconsistent herewith are hereby
2 repealed.
