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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 142 of the  
Public Laws of the year 1887, relating to Savings  
Banks.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 92 of chapter 47 of the Re-  
vised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter  
142 of the Public Laws of the year 1887, is hereby  
further amended by inserting after the word "any"  
in the fifth line of said section 92, as amended, the  
word 'one,' so that said section 92, as hereby  
amended, shall read as follows:

'SECT. 92. The officers of every such corpora-  
tion shall consist of a president, treasurer, and

10 when in the opinion of the trustees necessary, a  
11 vice president and an assistant treasurer, and not  
12 less than five trustees, not more than two of whom  
13 shall be directors in any one National bank, who  
14 shall elect from their number, or otherwise, such  
15 other officers as they see fit.'
