STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of dairying, beef raising, sheep, horses, swine, poultry growing interests, mechanical and manufacturing industries in the State.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-five hundred 2 dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the 3 Maine State Agricultural Society, and twenty-five 4 hundred dollars to the Eastern Maine State Fair, 5 of which there shall be paid the sum of twelve 6 hundred and fifty dollars to each of said societies 7 during the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, 8 and twelve hundred and fifty dollars to each of 9 said societies during the year eighteen hundred 10 and ninety, provided that each of said societies ap-11 propriate an amount equal to the sum herein 12 appropriated, and, in addition thereto, for pre-

13 miums to the classes mentioned in this resolve; 14 provided, also, that each of said societies shall 15 cause the prohibitory liquor law to be enforced on 16 all grounds over which they may have control.

Four hundred dollars of said appropriation shall 18 be appropriated annually by each society for the 19 purpose of encouraging the dairying interests in 20 this State; four hundred dollars for the purpose of 21 encouraging the raising of beef and fat cattle in 22 this State; four hundred dollars for the purpose of 23 encouraging the growing of sheep in this State; 24 four hundred dollars for the purpose of en-25 couraging the growing of horses in this State; one 26 hundred dollars for the purpose of encouraging 27 the growing of swine in this State; four hundred 28 dollars for the purpose of encouraging the grow-29 ing of poultry in, this State; and four hundred 30 dollars for the purpose of encouraging the me-31 chanical and manufacturing industries in this 32 State.

The several sums shall be offered in premiums to 34 be competed for by the citizens of this State.

The list of premiums shall be arranged jointly by 36 the executive officers of the two societies, together 37 with the president and secretary of the Board of 38 Agriculture.
