MAJORITY REPORT.

IN HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, }
January 15, 1889.

Ordered, That the Committee on the Judiciary
2 be instructed to inquire into the expediency of
3 submitting to a vote by the people of a resolve for
4 amending the constitution of the State, changing
5 the time for holding the State election from the
6 second Monday of September, biennially, to the
7 Tuesday next following the first Monday of No-
8 vember, and report by resolve or otherwise.

STATE OF MAINE.

A majority of the Committee on the Judiciary, to which was referred the order of the legislature instructing that committee to inquire into the expediency of submitting to a vote by the people of a resolve for amending the constitution of this State, changing the time for holding the State elections from the second Monday of September, biennially, to the Tuesday next following the first Monday of November, have had the same under consideration, and ask leave to report that legislation thereon is inexpedient.
