STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to simplify procedure in civil causes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All courts which are vested with juris-
2 diction, both at law and in equity, may hereafter, to
3 the full extent of their respective jurisdictions, ad-
4 minister legal and equitable rights, and apply legal
5 and equitable remedies in favor of either party, in
6 one and the same suit, so that legal and equitable
7 rights of the parties may be enforced and pro-
8 tected in one action, *provided*, that wherever there
9 is any variance between the rules of equity and
10 the rules of the common law, in reference to the
11 same matter, the rules of equity shall prevail.
