## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to incorporate the York Harbor Bridge Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Samuel S. Allen, Edward S. Marshall,

- 2 Samuel W. Jenkins, Jeremiah P. Simpson, Wilson
- 3 M. Walker, Edward Lowe and Daniel B. Harris,
- 4 their associates and successors, are hereby created a
- 5 corporation by the name of York Harbor Bridge
- 6 Company, with all the rights and privileges and sub-
- 7 ject to all the duties and obligations of such corpo-
- 8 rations under the laws of the State.
  - SECT. 2. Said corporation may construct and 2 maintain a bridge across York river in the town of

- 3 York, crossing Bragdon's and Harris' Islands, so
- 4 called, and may maintain a way as a part thereof
- 5 or convenient for approaching thereto, provided
- 6 that said corporation shall build and maintain, at
- 7 its own expense, a draw in said bridge sufficient
- 8 and convenient, for the passage of all vessels navi-
- 9 gating said river.
- SECT. 3. The capital stock of said corporation 2 shall not exceed twenty thousand dollars to be 3 divided into shares of one hundred dollars each.
  - SECT. 4. The directors of said corporation may,
  - 2 from time to time, fix reasonable tolls for the use
  - 3 of said bridge and way, and receive and collect the
  - 4 same, provided, however, that the county commis-
  - 5 sioners of York county, upon petition by any party
  - 6 using said bridge, and notice and hearing, may
  - 7 revise the tolls fixed by the directors and make
  - 8 such changes therein as said commissioners deem
  - 9 reasonable; and the corporation shall be bound by
- 10 such revision and shall not increase the tolls so
- 11 fixed unless upon its petition, public notice and
- 12 hearing said commissioners shall consent thereto.
