STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of a road in Andover, North Surplus, in the county of Oxford.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars

- 2 be, and hereby is appropriated, to aid in repairing
- 3 that part of the road leading from Andover to the
- 4 arm of the Richardson Lake, in Oxford county,
- 5 which lies in Andover North Surplus, the same to
- 6 be drawn by and expended under the direction of
- 7 the county commissioners of Oxford county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road leads to a vast fishing and hunting section, where many tourists go in summer and fall. There are cottages and hotels at the arm of the lake. The land in North Surplus, through which this road passes, is poor and cannot be assessed to the extent necessary to raise the money needed. There is another road passing through the westerly side of the Surplus, so that only about half the assessment made can be expended on this road leading to the arm of the lake. The road is full of large rocks, deep cuts, and unsafe to pass over. There is quite a large amount of travel over it, and the land is not sufficiently valuable to support it by tax. The road through the Surplus is three and one-half miles in length, and from Andover to arm of lake, about twelve miles.
