RESOLVE in favor of Town of Frenchville.

---

*Resolved,* That two hundred dollars be and here-  
2 by is appropriated to aid the town of Frenchville  
3 in re-building a bridge across Guerritt brook in  
4 said town, the same to be expended under the  
5 direction of the county commissioners of Aroos-  
6 took county.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The bridge referred to in the resolve was built fourteen years ago. It is not high enough to clear the logs running in stream in driving time, and as it is a State road and stage line, the bridge must be rebuilt and raised so as to clear logs running in the stream. It will cost at least \$600 to rebuild same but inhabitants of Frenchville only ask for an appropriation of \$200, being willing to raise the remaining amount themselves.
