STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty of the Revised
Statutes, establishing a bounty on Crows.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. A bounty of ten cents for every
2 crow killed, in any town in this State, between the
3 thirty-first day of March and the first day of Novem-
4 ber of each year, shall be paid by the treasurer
5 thereof, to the person depositing, in lots of ten or
6 more, the heads of the same with such treasurer,
7 the treasurer shall immediately destroy such heads
8 by fire.

SECT. 2. Towns shall be reimbursed, and its
2 treasurer shall require and give similar certificates

3 and receipts and be qualified to administer the same
4 oath as made and provided in section six, seven and
5 eight of chapter thirty of the Revised Statutes.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
