STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 58 of the Revised Statutes, relating to State aid to Agricultural Societies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section eleven of chapter fifty-eight 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out 3 the first nine lines and inserting the following. 4 There shall be appropriated annually from the 5 State Treasurer a sum of money not exceeding one 6 cent to each inhabitant of the State, which shall be 7 divided among the legally incorporated agricultural 8 societies of the State not provided for by special 9 enactment according to the amount of premiums 10 and gratuities awarded by said societies; provided

11 that no society shall receive from the State a sum 12 greater than that actually raised and payed by the 13 societies for said purposes. This section is further 14 amended by striking out all between the word dol-15 lars in the fourteenth line and societies in the six-16 teenth line and all after the word dollars in the 17 eighteenth line, so that said section as amended 18 shall read as follows:

'SECT. 11, chapter fifty-eight. There shall be 20 appropriated annually from the State Treasurer a 21 sum of money not exceeding one cent to each in-22 habitant of the State, which shall be divided among 23 the legally incorporated agricultural societies of 24 the State, not provided for by special enactment, 25 according to the amount of premiums and gratui-26 ties awarded by said societies provided that no 27 society shall receive from the State a sum greater 28 than that actually raised and paid by the society 29 for said purposes. But the Penobscot and Aroos-30 took Union Agricultural society may annually 31 receive as much as is raised by it not exceeding $\mathbf{32}$ one hundred dollars without regard to population, 33 and the Waldo and Penobscot Agricultural society 34 as much as is raised by it not exceeding one 35 hundred and thirty dollars, and the Ossipee

36 Valley Union Agricultural society not exceeding37 two hundred dollars.
