STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for preservation of Ex-Governor King's
Monument.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury
2 of the State, three hundred dollars, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary to repair the grounds,
4 cleanse the monument and properly fence the burial
5 grounds of Ex-Governor King and that the same
6 be expended under the direction of the Park and
7 Cemetery Board of the city of Bath.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The State erected this monument many years ago. Private parties erected an iron fence around the same, which is much broken and requires extensive repairs, if not a new one. Nothing has been done to the lot, a fifty-foot triangle, the monument or fence, since their erection.
